



Since we are all being forced to use paper bags when grocery shopping and don't seem to have too many uses for them after that. This can be a way to use them and keep the kids busy and inside. I call it **City Planning**. Kids have a great imagination so this is easy.



Directions: Take 3 to 4 grocery bags cutting them open and then tape them together like a giant square. Keeping tape side down, give the kids a black marker and have them draw streets going all over the place like highways or country roads. Have them put in places for parks and maybe draw a few rivers. A floor plan for a city. Then fill in the spaces using blocks or legos to build buildings, bridges, garages stc. For the parks, sponges can be used as trees and shrubs. Pencils can be light posts or struts for bridges and they can use their lego cars and match boxes for transportation. It can be as simple or complicated as you want it, but it should keep everyone busy for a bit.
