

Letter Search Activity!

You first need to take a piece of 8 1/2 by 11-inch paper and fold it in half vertically. Put the folded piece of paper in front of you holding the paper the "hot dog" way. Make 3 equal rows across. Make 10 columns so you will have 30 boxes (see example.) Number boxes 1-30 and then follow the clues. You will put one letter in each box. When you're done you will have spelled out a sentence. There should be no spaces between the words. Catch the mistake that is getting in the way of the message! Hint: One letter does not belong and only *one* letter.

This letter appears 7 times. Cross it out, and then read the sentence. Maybe after you're done, you can make your own hidden message and clues and have your family figure it out!

- What is the first letter in the name of something that shines in the sky during the day? Put that letter in Box 17.
- You need a "b" a "k," and two of the letters in the middle spell the word "book." Put one of those middle letters in Box 15.
- What sound does a cow make? Put the first letter of the word we use to describe that sound in Box 24.
- Which letter of the alphabet looks most like what a chicken lays? Put it in Box 27.
- Here's an easy one. Put the first letter of the alphabet in Boxes 2 and 10.
- Oops! The chicken has done it again! It has laid another of those things that look like a letter. Put the letter in Box 9.

- When you wash your hands at a sink, you often see two letters. One is a "C." What is the other letter? Put it in Box 22.
- Remember those round things the chicken laid? It happened again in Boxes 19 and 23.
- Put the fifth letter of the alphabet in Box 6.
- Which letter of the alphabet comes between "C" and "E?" Put that letter in Box 11.
- What is the first letter in the name of the meal you eat at school in the middle of the day? Put it in Box 14.
- One letter of the alphabet looks like a letter "M" which has been turned upside-down. Which one is it? Put it in Box 26.
- Oh, my! I hear the chicken again! This time it has hopped into Box 4 and laid another of those things that look like an alphabet letter.
- Think of a little mound of dirt with lots of insects crawling around. Sometimes these insects come to picnics. What is the first letter in their name? Put it in Box 21.
- What is the first letter in the word that means the opposite of "true?" Put it in Box 20.
- Speaking of opposites, what is the first letter in the word that is the opposite of "short?" Put it in Box 8.
- What is the first letter in the name of the room where you find a stove and a refrigerator? Put it in Box 29.
- You see a lot of red hearts on this special day. What is the first letter in the name of this day? Put it box 5.
- What is the first letter in the three-letter word for something water becomes when it freezes? Put that letter in Box 1.
- If I were saying the alphabet over and over, which letter would I say each time after I said the letter "Z?" Put that letter in Boxes 7, 13, 18, and 30.
- Cackle, cackle! Put another of those round things in Box 12.
- The U.S flag is blue, white and another color which starts with this letter. Put in Box 28.
- I see these every time you give me a big smile. They stay nice and white if you brush them. Put that letter in their name in Box 16.
- If you spelled the word "elbow" the way it sounds, you would probably use this letter first. Put it in Box 3.
- What is it that chicken lays? They lay something that "looks" like a letter, but of course, the thing they lay has a name. What is the first letter in that name? Put in box 25.
